

SOUTHERN HILLS GC

Tournament season is in full swing and a few weeks ago I was invited to attend the Veterans Touchdown Club event at Southern Hills. This was my first experience playing at this track and I will say I was impressed. Of the many things I look for well it had real grass growing so right away I was happy to get out there. The 25 short road trip southeast of WR is well worth the drive for the day. Surprisingly out of no where the entrance pops up you see the clubhouse perched up on top of a hill and looking around you notice one thing. This is not the country.. This is a thriving golf community.

Unexpected was the neighborhood surrounding the property but illustrates the players commitment to this club. While I am no fan of houses on a golf course at all, I understand why I was shocked to see a very solid clubhouse with every facility ready to serve customers in all capacities from the Golf Shop to the Food and Beverage operations. The practice areas where in good shape so your day can start off the right way before you make your way out for the challenge this course presents. It is not often I walk into a "club in the country" that has the presence of a city private club but Southern Hills has done a great job to represent itself as a top contender in the Houston County area and even for the entire central GA area as well.

The golf course offers wide fairways which is common for a community supported club and it is inviting for the tournament fundraising crowd. What I enjoyed most is how the course navigates the hills its built on. Starting up top from the clubhouse there are a hand full of holes in the high point of the property and then you begin to descend through the hills and around down to the low points where the lakes are. The back nine has a great convergence of holes which creates an opportunity to raise the conditions to real tournament level play as well. 4 Knuckles on my count!

Learn To Train Properly by



One of the many aspects missing in developing players in athletics is the type of training designed with developing skills and the lack of positive and accurate feedback used in conjunction with the sessions players go through. Not only do most players, but for sure most golfers miss so many steps in trying to develop in their games but they don't even consider what is the proper process? Do I have the tools needed and the plans in place to actually develop skills that lead to actual results?

Well we all consider and know how Athletes perform various activities day to day in order to achieve and maintain peak performance levels while trying to compete in their sport. Why do golfers in general think the exact same types of activities are not required in golf? Well I can't fully answer that question 100% without a additional column dedicated to just that. For now I will include this. Golf as seen by the casual observer on tv on a Sunday afternoon simply appears to be a "effort free" activity. Based on this one observance alone one would tend to think that it looks "easy" or "simple". Any player who was worked hard to develop golf skills will laugh immediately. While we may not need brute strength and agility that a linebacker in the NFL needs to make a tackle the golf swing if done in its most effective and efficient form requires movements that most amateur players do not have.

So how do everyday players learn and develop the skills needed? Well I will keep some of this to my training sessions with my players, however I will describe the basics. Once a skill position or movement is identified that is required for he player to have a chance at advancement, a process must be put in place for that player to realistically learn the skill first before they can apply it. See it feel it and even hear when you have achieved a new position or move is required for a player to even have a chance of applying it in full speed. Controlled identifiable training is more important then a slug fest on the range. The types of "walk through drills" NFL players do and other various sports is an illustration of the "training" needed before we can try to apply skills or movements. Having a coach who knows the process well from decades of experience can really help speed things up. While it takes time to develop new skills a properly educated and trained coach can give a player the weekly assignment and athletic training needed. Next time when you are in the practice area ask yourself this "am I doing things correctly? If you don't know I think the answer is probably clear. "Hitting" a bunch of golf balls is not proper training. There are a lot of other detailed things required for players to make changes occur but also to develop into lasting change. I have developed and redeveloped a process for my players that guarantees success. It does take proper sessions of focused work and the learning environment to do this successfully.



GOLF SCHOOL

The golf swing has a series of movements that become a interconnected sequence of actions that incur cause and the effect throughout the entire golf swing. Lets use the P system to help explain. Each major position in the golf swing has been defined over the past 50 years. P1, P2 etc. from setup to finish each major point of reference is identified. When we swing each point has its "good" and "bad" possible positions. When players reach say P4 and something is really moving to the "bad" side then they will be forced into correcting it at some point later in the swing. More often then not it's the next one or in this case P5 will be forced into a recorrective action that actually has another negative effect on the next position P6. Every player has a priority list of Ps to fix. My job as a coach is to identify these for each player and then properly select what is needed depending on the level of player. The coaching craft is more important then "knowing" the golf swing. That parts easy.
